



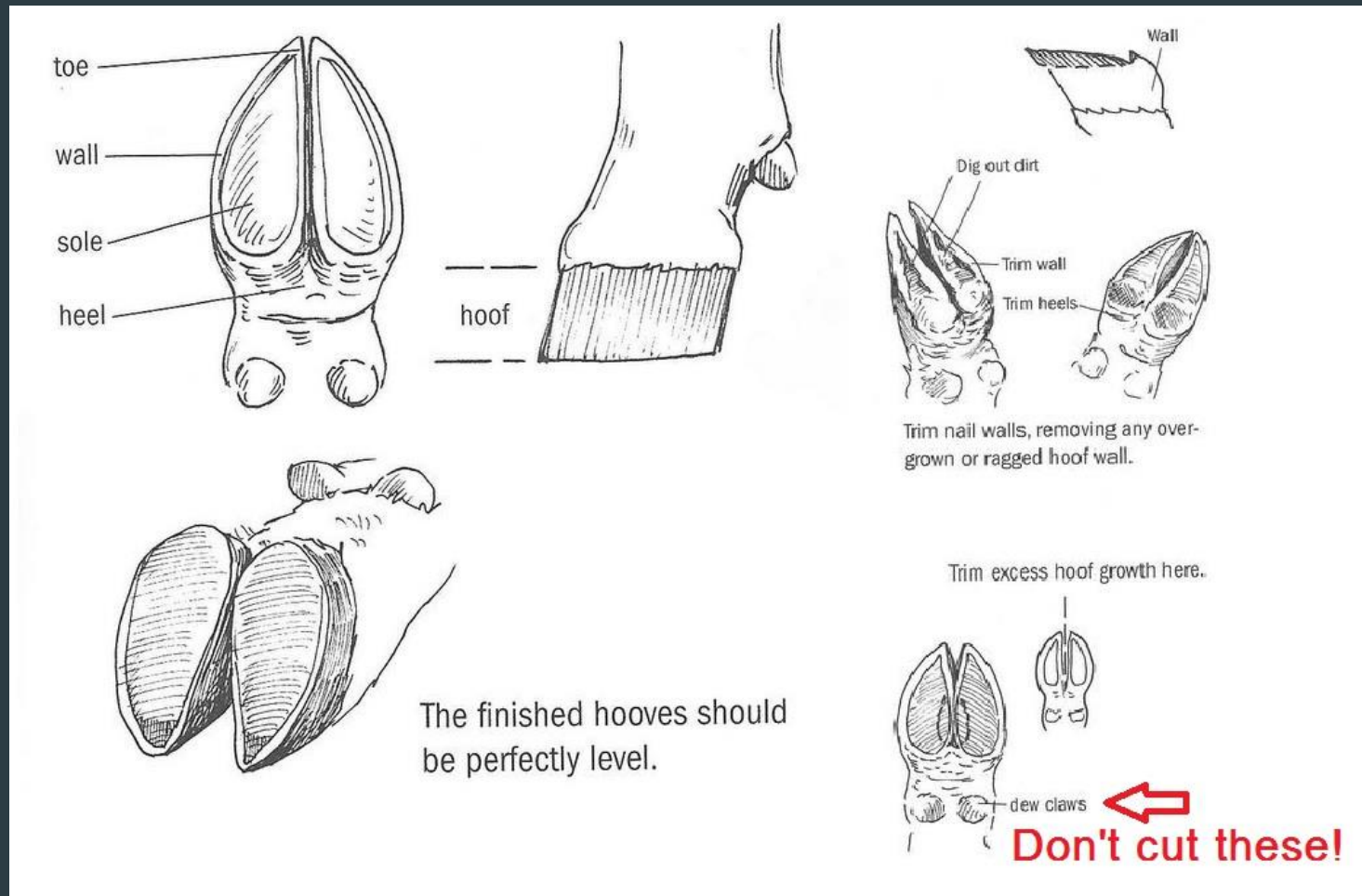

Common Foot Problems



- ▶ Overgrown hoof
- ▶ Foot rot
- ▶ Hoof scald
- ▶ Abscesses
- ▶ Any combination



Prevention/Treatment Options



▶ Prevention

- ▶ Clean dry environment
- ▶ Regular hoof trimming

▶ Topical treatments

- ▶ Kopertox
- ▶ Dr. Naylor's Hoof & Heel
- ▶ Foot bath/soak
 - ▶ Epsom salts & water
 - ▶ Copper or zinc sulfate & water

▶ Treatment - severe cases

- ▶ Prevention measures
- ▶ Topical treatments
 - ▶ foot wraps - need to stay clean & dry
 - ▶ Boots - change every 2 days
- ▶ Systemic antibiotics
 - ▶ Penicillin
 - ▶ LA 200
 - ▶ Rx antibiotics

Goat Hoof Care



You will have some degree of feet issues due to the wet environment.

Regular observation -pick up feet once monthly

Routine hoof trimming - every 2 to 3 months

Treat early and often especially with topical treatments.
